Budget Billing:

Residential consumers may request a Budget Billing Plan whereby they can pay a fixed amount each month on a yearly basis in lieu of monthly billings based on actual usage.

The monthly fixed amount for each consumer is based on actual or estimated consumption made by a Cooperative representative. However, the Cooperative may adjust the billing amounts after notification if metered consumption, rates, and fuel charge adjustments indicate significant change from the advance estimate.

The equal monthly payments for 12 months will begin with the July bill and any difference between the amount paid and the actual use during the 12 month period will be adjusted by adding or crediting the electric service bill for the following June.

Failure to make monthly budget payments when due, subjects this plan to cancellation and the consumer will be required to pay any under-payment to make the account current.
