Delayed Payment Charge:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid before or on the 18th of the following month, five percent will be added.

Special Rules:

(a) The village shall turn the lights on and off.

(b) Street lighting equipment, including the necessary street lighting circuits and poles will be furnished by the Cooperative to the extent of a total investment of not over \$25.00 per lamp. At the discretion of the Cooperative additional street lamps will be installed from time to time under the same limitations without charge for installation upon written request from the village. Any excess cost must be borne by the village.

(c) Lamp replacement shall be made by the village.

Availability of Service:

To large power consumers served by the Cooperative located at or near its three-phase lines.

Type of Service:

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at standard secondary voltage. 2-480, 2-120/208 and 1-120/240.

Rates:

\$1.00 per month per KW of billing demand

Plus energy charge of:

First 2,000 kwh per month @
Next 18,000 kwh per month @
Next 30,000 kwh per month @
Next 50,000 kwh per month @
Over 100,000 kwh per month @

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Minimum Charge:

The minimum charge under the above rate shall be 75¢ per kva of required transformer capacity or fraction thereof per month but in no case shall the minimum charge be less than \$25.00 per month.

Delayed Payment Charge:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being five percent higher on the first \$25.00 and 2% on the remainder of the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid before or on the 18th day of the following month, the gross rates shall apply.

Terms:

(a) The consumer shall give satisfactory assurance supported by a written agreement as to the character, amount, and duration of the business offered.

(b) The consumer shall guarantee a minimum annual revenue of not less than 18% of the estimated additional investment required to extend service, which shall include the additional cost of meters, transformers, and many additions to or alterations of lines and equipment necessary to make service available. Minimum charges for service shall be based on the additional investment only when this results in greater charges than those based on the kva of installed transformer capacity as hereinbefore provided.

Special Rules:

(a) Power Factor; The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his minimum demand is less than 80%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 80% and divided by the percent power factor.

(b) Determination of Billing Demand; The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

(c) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H. P.) must be three-phase.

(d) The consumer must connect lighting to power circuits from the power meter. Any additional transformers or regulating equipment which may be required for such lighting shall be furnished by the consumer.

(e) All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, exclusive of the service transformers and protective equipment, is considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

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
