Where it is necessary to extend or reinforce facilities in excess of standard service facilities, the minimum monthly charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities of one and one-half (1 1/2) percent per month of the total cost of the excess facilities as a facilities charge for which no power and energy would be delivered.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

Compensating starting equipment may be required for all motors when specified by the seller because of power line characteristics.

DELIVERY POINT:

Unless otherwise specified in the service contract, the delivery point shall be the connection between conductors furnished and installed by the seller and the conductors furnished and installed by the consumer. All wiring, pole lines and other equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the consumer.

(q) In unusual circumstances, when the application of these rules appear impracticable or unjust to either party, or discriminatory to other customers, the Cooperative or applicant shall refer the matter to the Public Service Commission for a special ruling or for the approval of special conditions which may be mutually agreed upon, prior to commencing construction.

(r) Where only secondary conductors are involved, the Cooperative shall install underground conductors as follows:

1. If the Cooperative trenches and backfills and installs the secondary conductor, the applicant shall pay one dollar and thirty-five cents (\$1.35) per ground foot (pole to house) prior to the commencement of such construction. (R)

2. Where the applicant performs the trenching and backfilling with the Cooperative installing the secondary conductors, a fifty-nine cent (\$.59) per foot credit shall be allowed under "b", 1, above. All other terms and conditions set forth in Sections "E" 1, 2 and 3 which are not in conflict with this section "E", 3(r) shall also apply. (I) (T)

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
