- 05/11/17 Final Order Entered: 1. Red Barn is assessed a penalty of \$12,500.00 for its willful failure to comply with KRS 278.230 and 807 KAR 5:006, Section 4(2). 2. Red Barn is assessed a penalty of \$12,500.00 for its willful failure to comply with KRS 278.140. 3. The penalties assessed against Red Barn in this Order are suspended. 4. If Red Barn receives approval for its transfer to Mercer Sanitation, the penalties will be waived upon successful completion of the transfer. 5. Should the Commission deny Red Barn's application for transfer, or Red Barn should withdraw its application, Red Barn shall pay the assessed penalty of \$25,000.00 within 14 days of the date of the denial or withdrawal of the application. Payment shall be by certified check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, Commonwealth of Kentucky" and shall be sent by certified mail or delivered to Office of General Counsel, Public Service Commission of Kentucky, 211 Sower Boulevard, P.O.
